## THE GLACIAL CONTROVERSY.

To the Editor.

Sir—In The Register of October 27, a German academician, Dr. Fritz Noetling, has, under this heading, tacitly belittled the qualifications of Dr. Herbert Basedow, of Adelaide, one of the legally qualified medical practitioners of our State. I am not myself in a position to take part in the glacial controversy, but as an outsider I cannot grasp the connection between glacial action and medical qualifications, but suspect something deeper behind it all. In defence of Dr. Basedow, however, I can confidently state that had our local Medical Board not been satisfied with that gentleman's qualifications, I am sure they would not have registered his name. I am quite unbiassed myself, as I do not know Dr. Noetling at all, and have only met Dr. Basedow on two occasions. But when an outsider, such as Dr. Noetling, who is not a medical man, endeavours to harm one of our profession for obvious reasons, it is time to see to fair play. Dr. Noetling has published statements which are contradictions to the statutes of Prussian universities. I have taken the trouble to look up the requirements for the German M.D. and find that clause 5 reads:—"If the candidate has not passed the German 'Staats-examen' he is required to prove to the faculty of medicine that (1) he has passed the matriculation examination (or the equivalent thereof) necessary for entering upon the medical course in a German university; (2) that he has attended a regular science medical course of the same duration as is required for the German Staats-examen before he can sit for his final examinations. The subjects of examination include anatomy and morbid anatomy, physiology, pharmacology, general pathology, and medicine, surgical pathology and surgery, toxicology, medical jurisprudence and obstetrics. If the candidate be successful and the certificates of general and medical education be satisfactory, he receives a diploma and promises to hold his academical honour with dignity." These printed statements hardly coincide with Dr. Noetling's, who maintains that the German M.D. is but an "ornamental handle." Is it, moreover, at all likely that any Prussian university, noted for its officialism, would override any of their statutes for the special benefit of an absolute stranger, as Dr. Basedow no doubt was to them? I have followed this controversy with interest, and have read Dr. Basedow's explanation that the faculty of medicine allowed him the science subjects on account of his science course at Adelaide University. Thus he completed his medical course in little over three years instead of five years. To me this appears not at all extraordinary, especially when the student is more advanced in years and works with a will. The licentiate course at Edinburgh is only a four years' course all told. If, therefore, the German authorities allowed Dr. Basedow the science subjects, it amounts to the same thing. Gottingen University, above all German universities, enjoys a reputation of long standing. With it are associated among hundreds of others, the names of such as Bismarck, Goethe, Blumenbach, Wohler, Flatter, and so on. The university has ever been in close connection with England, William III. of England having contributed £3,000 to its building fund. In the records of our own profession we find the German M.D. much in evidence as an honourable distinction. The

names of Professor Watson, Drs. Gosse, Gunson, Gorer, Angus Johnson, and others might be mentioned.
