Dear Snedecor,

Thanks for your letter of November 23rd, and for allowing no obstacle to be put to the publication of Norton's table in conjunction with the other percentile points. I hope to mention Norton's association with the State College in the preface.

I am afraid I have a difficulty which you may not know of in assigning the particular symbol "F" to the variance ratio, and that is, that a table of this value derived from my table of  $\underline{g}$  was published in India, I think in Sankhya, before yours. The author, if I remember right, used a different symbol - probably  $\underline{x}$ . I feel it would be too complicated to make a sub-heading using the different designations.

Yates seems to have enjoyed his trip immensely, with very moderate weather at Ames, it seems. Even in Winter, though, Bombay was uncomfortably hot, though most of the places I visited were very pleasant.
