



ADELAIDE UNI TO ABSORB FLINDERS

The Sanderman Enquiry into Post Secondary Education has recommended that Flinders University be combined with Adelaide University.

The combined institution will be known as the University of South Australia (USA).

The Sanderman Enquiry also recommended that the emphasis of the USA will be on commerce and economics. In particular, the Enquiry urges the formation of a Department of Exploitation and Aboriginal Studies.

It is expected that the University's shareholding in Uranium mining companies will fund this department. The Chairman of the enquiry Mr. U.T. Ha Ltd, said that the Enquiry was concerned that the Universities were losing track of what the Federal Government was committed to in its policies.

It was hoped that the general irrelevance of Universities to common people would be enhanced by the new arrangement. When asked to comment, the man widely tipped to be the Vice-Chancellor of USA Professor John Cur said "After all, the general public does not have a degree let alone an academic reputation so who are they to make decisions about Universities."

The Enquiries recommendation also included

*A means test for applicants such that if their income is too low they are not accepted.

*Implementation of a zoning system similar to that used for secondary

schools. Only students drawn from east of the line running through Springfield, St. Georges, Beaumont, Athelstone will be accepted.

Observers say that these proposals shall make little difference to the present intake. They consider this as a more secure method of enforcing the present socio-economic bias already present in the educational system.

Amongst other benefits the new system will mean the virtual elimination of the left wing radical element from the student body, the Committee states.

An increased work load is expected to ensure that students spend time on nothing but their course load. The Committee describes this as a minor change in the light of the 3rd term experience.

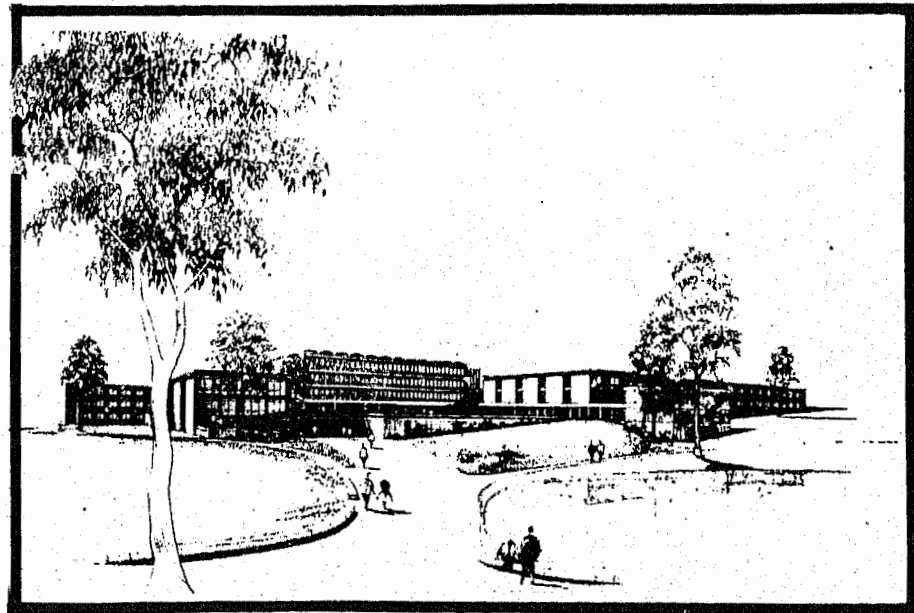

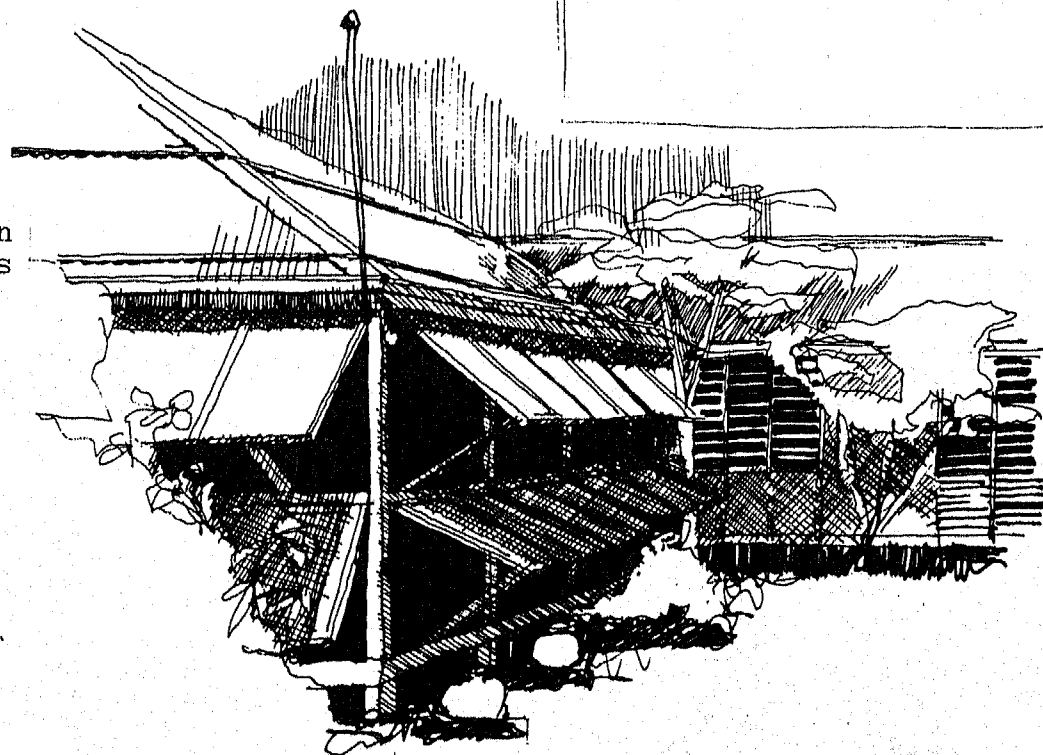
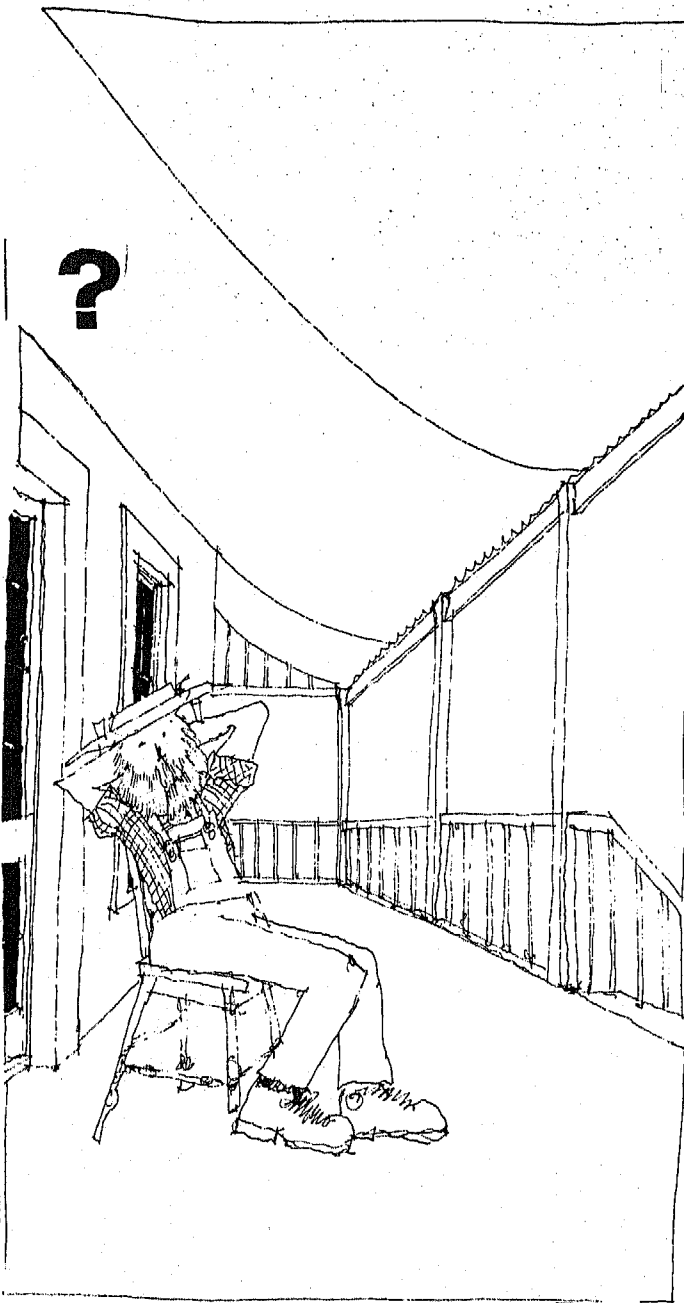
Applications for the Non Collegiate Housing Scheme for 1979 are now open. Accommodation is available for about 45 students in houses in North Adelaide.

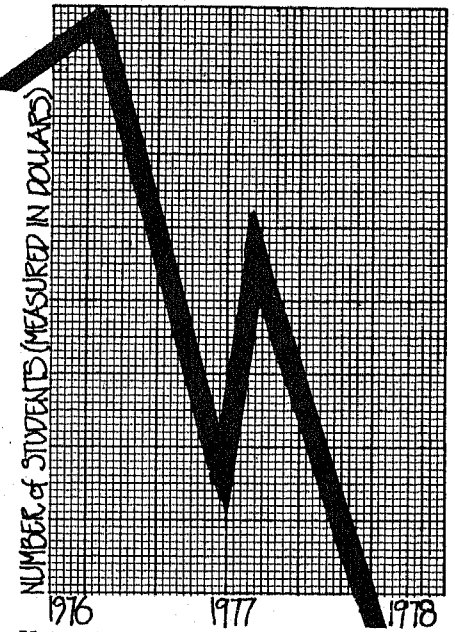
STUDENT DIVIDEND DOWN

According to the latest Federal Government figures, the dividend paid to Universities for investing in students has dropped for Adelaide University.

The 1978 return to the University was \$4,490 per student whereas the 1979 figure is down by \$57 per student.

In total this represents a drop in the University's return for investing in students of \$484,500.

The Managing Director of the University Mr. Long Planks, said that this posed large economic problems within the organisation. However, he expects that with sound managerial strategy, the problem could be overcome. Apart from adopting the usual business practice of reducing staff levels and delaying renewal and replacement of capital equipment, the Board of Directors of the



University are looking at ways of artificially increasing the investment in students.

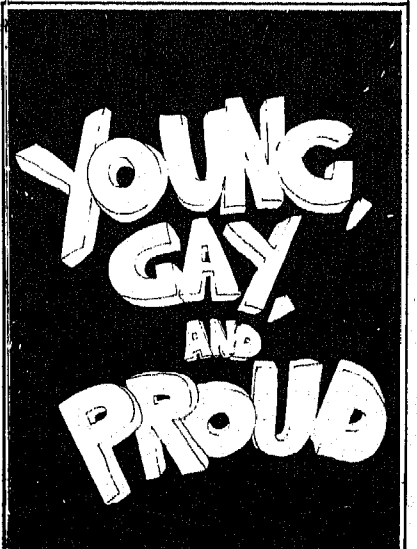
"In this way we hope to offset the reduction in return" he said.

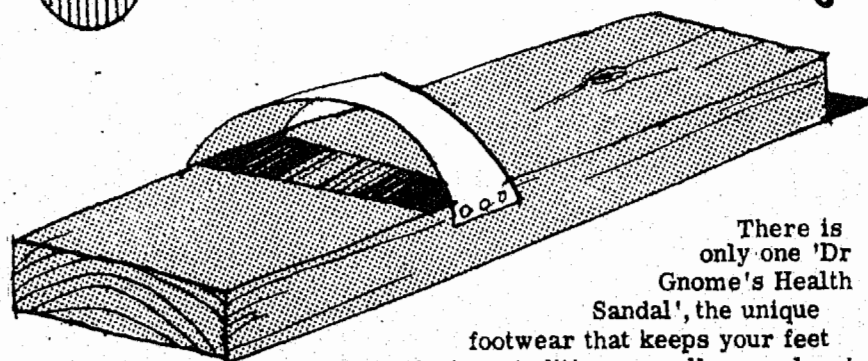
