THE UNIVERSITY EXAMINATIONS.

To-day is the last day of entry for the junior, senior, and higher public examinations at the Adelaide University, as well as for the junior commercial public examinations and for the examinations in the theory and practice of music, which are to be held next month. The junior and senior public examinations in the theory of music are to begin on November 1, the Angus engineering exhibition, and junior and higher public examinations begin on November 14, while the senior public examination and the junior commercial examinations begin on November 20. The age limit of candidates so far as concerns the prizes given by the University for the best students in the junior examination is 18 years, the awards being £10, £5, and £3 respectively. Similar prizes are offered in connection with the senior examination, the qualifying age limit in respect to which is also 18 years according to the University calendar for the current year. The candidate obtaining the highest number of marks in the higher public examination, if under the age of 19 years, is awarded the Hartley studentship, which exempts him from all lecture and examination fees for three years in either the B.A. or B.Sc. degree course. Other scholarships, each of which is tenable for three years, are granted by the Education Department in connection with the higher public examination, and they are of the value of £35, £30, and £25 respectively, although the University calendar for 1905 sets the second amount at £20 instead of £30.
