THE Adelaide University Theatre Guild has been founded to advance the study and appreciation of drama through the production of plays. A sense of the theatre, and of theatrical conditions special to an age, is increasingly recognized as an important element in the understanding of dramatic literature and the Guild will produce plays of various periods and countries in the light of knowledge of this sort. The Guild will arrange discussions, readings, lectures and other activities subsidiary to this end.

The resources of the Guild, financial, material and in point of active and experienced members, are at present limited: it believes that it will justify itself in its activities and receive increasing support. A satisfactory stage has been built and much is already being done under the guidance of people familiar with amateur theatrical work.

It is hoped that the endeavours of the Guild will become part of the life of the University and that both graduate and undergraduate members will help it to fulfil its aims.
