


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

Andri was the illegitimate son of the teacher and the Senora from over the enemy border. The teacher was afraid to reveal his association with one of the enemy and said that Andri was a Jew whom he had saved from their persecution. Just as Andri had accepted himself as a Jew, as one who was different from the rest of the people of Andorra, it became necessary to tell him that he was in fact one of them - the son of the teacher. But Andri could not believe them now; he would not trust them. The people at any rate refused to believe it, not because they mistrusted the teacher's work, but because it was expedient to have Andri, the Jew. They needed a scapegoat as a cover for their own guilt.
