Dr. Kenneth Fry, one of the South Australian Rhodes scholars, returned to Adelaide on Saturday after an absence of about four and a half years. On his way to England he visited Japan and America, and, in addition to spending three years at Oxford till June, 1912, he travelled a good deal on the Continent. At Oxford he obtained the B.Sc. degree for research work in anthropology. Having secured the diploma of public health and the diploma of anthropology, Dr. Fry accepted a Government position in the Northern Territory under Dr. Gilruth towards the end of last year, and he arrived at his post shortly before Christmas. After nine months' experience in the Territory he reluctantly decided to resign, as he felt that the local authorities had made the conditions impossible for him. Dr. Fry was beginning to get deeply interested in anthropological research among the aborigines, but in the comparatively short time of his stay in the Territory he was unable to proceed far with his investigations, which were chiefly confined to the Bathurst and Melville Island blacks. It had been his hope to continue his anthropological study for several years.

THE MELBOURNE UNIVERSITY.
FUTURE NEEDS.
MELBOURNE, October 28.
In its report on the future needs of the university, the committee of enquiry appointed by the university council proposes that all graduates, whether male or female, shall be members of the senate; that the personnel of the council of the university should be increased to 34, including four members of Parliament, one representative of external interests and one graduate representative of undergraduates; that the annual State endowment should be increased, first to £47,500, and ultimately to £50,000; that £60,000 be granted by the State for immediate building requirements; that a permanent President be appointed; that the teaching staff be largely increased; that university fees should not be abolished; that financial provision be made for the establishment of adult tutorial classes.

UNIVERSITY COUNCIL.
Adjourned debate on the motion of the CHIEF SECRETARY—"That the Council, in accordance with the provisions of the Adelaide University Amendment Act, 1911, do now proceed to ballot for a member to fill the vacancy on the council of the Adelaide University, caused by the death of the Hon. Sir J. J. Duncan."
The Hon. J. H. VAUGHAN said he had on the previous day of sitting moved the adjournment of the debate because he had desired to give the Chamber the opportunity to consider the matter of electing a member from his side of it to the vacancy on the University Council. Having obtained that opportunity, and as the vote was to be by ballot, he did not think it would be proper for him to say any more at that juncture.
Motion agreed to. The Council proceeded to ballot.
The PRESIDENT—The Hon. Sir John Downer is selected to fill the vacancy.
