The will of the late Mrs. Jane Marks, of Grange-road, West Hindmarsh, widow of Mr. George Richard Marks, has been admitted to probate. The estate is sworn not to exceed £153,000. There are a number of legacies, several of them of £5,000 each, to relatives of Mr. Marks and other persons. The testatrix provides a sum of £10,000 to be applied to such charitable institution or institutions or other charitable objects in South Australia as her trustees may select, and in such proportions as they may think fit, and as previously announced in "The Advertiser," a sum of £30,000 is left to the Adelaide University for the purpose of perpetuating the memory of the testatrix's husband, Mr. George Richard Marks, and that of the testatrix, and for the better advancement of the medical school of the University. The income from the bequest is to be applied in founding a professorship, or in such other manner as the council of the University think best in the interest of the medical school, such professorship or scholarships to be called the Marks professorship or the Marks scholarships.
