The Hughes Professorship of English Language and Literature and Mental and Moral Philosophy at the Adelaide University, rendered vacant by the transfer of Professor Boulenger to the Hughes Chair of Classics, occupied by the late Professor Kelly, was filled yesterday by the council, who appointed Dr. William Mitchell. The new professor, who is a master of arts and doctor of science of Edinburgh University, has had a most distinguished academic career, and is 33 years of age.
