**UNIVERSITY EXAMINATIONS.**—In our list of names in the practice of music the name of Miss Mary Kerr Harkness should have appeared in the senior division, first class, for pianoforte playing. Miss Hilda Beatrice Thomas (first class senior singing) and Miss Elsie K. Cowling (second class junior singing) were both pupils of Mr. A. Wyatt Mortimer, from Hardwicke College. The surnames of Miss Lily Mary Eames, Miss Amy Nina Curson, and Miss Mabel Jane Wilks were incorrectly given yesterday as "Ewins," "Carson," and "Wells," and "Mr. Alderman" appeared instead of Mrs. Alderman. The name of the teacher of Miss Beatrice Bertha Giddon was Miss E. E. Benson, not "Euron." The teacher in junior pianoforte playing of Miss Mary Ellen Austin, Miss Leask's school (incorrectly given as "Leask") was Mr. J. Williams. It should have been indicated that Miss Florence A. Cramp-ton, another of Mr. J. Williams's pupils, passed first class with credit in junior singing.

Mr. George Ash, M.P., was the subject of hearty congratulations from his colleagues in the Assembly on Wednesday when it became known that he had passed the third year of the examination in the Laws Course at the Adelaide University with honors and had been awarded the Stow prize. Last November Mr. Ash won the same distinction, which is given to the student who passes the best examination of his year, who gains credit in all the subjects prescribed, and who satisfies the examiners of his general proficiency. The Stow prize, which is named after the late Mr. Justice Stow, was established in 1883 for law students in each stage of their course through the University, but the conditions attached to it are so stringent that it has only been awarded ten times, although it is possible for it to have been won on thrice that number of occasions. When a student has carried it off in three years he is entitled to the Stow Scholarship, but so far only Mr. F. L. Stow has attained this coveted honor. Mr. T. Hewitson won the prize twice, and Mr. Ash has had similar good fortune, while in 1891 he was but one point short of getting it. Next year he will complete the bachelors of laws course, so that he has another chance for success.
