LECTURE ON THE AUSTRALIAN ABORIGINAL

One great authority had described the Australian native as the finest model of human proportions to be compared with the antique bust of a philosopher.

According to another authority, the aboriginal standard of development is superior to every variety of race. This explanation of this was that, given an isolated race, with a variety of environment, it would branch out into different types. This occurred in almost all animals, and was known as the convergence of characters.

The theory of the convergence of characters of the black race, and its distribution, the theory of the Director of Deep Sea Investigation, Dr. James Cook, is also quoted. This dealt with the geographical alteration of the earth and the possibility of a large continent having been known to the ancients.

The much-discussed problem of how the aboriginal got to Australia must be investigated. It is possible that the aboriginals came to Australia by sea. The aboriginals contrast they must look for the origin of human races. Therefore it might be assumed that the aboriginals were a mixture of two races.
