

Some Great Benefactors.



LATE SIR THOMAS ELDER,

one of the founders and the greatest benefactor of the University. He and the late Sir Walter Watson Hughes each gave £20,000 towards the foundation of the University. Subsequently, in subscriptions and bequests, Sir Thomas Elder gave the University additional sums amounting to nearly £80,000. He endowed Chairs in Mathematics and Natural Science (£20,000), a medical school (£30,000), and school of music (£20,000), as well as making an endowment for general purposes (£25,000), contributing towards a chair of music (£1,500), and providing £1,000 in 1888-9 to enable the council to establish a full medical curriculum.



THE LATE MR. R. BARR SMITH.

Who provided £9,000 for the purchase of books for the University Library.



THE HON. SIR LANGDON BONYTHON, K.C.M.G.,

who in 1921 gave the University £40,000 for the erection of a Great Hall, the South Australian Government to pay the £40,000 to the University in 1930."



THE LATE HON. J. H. ANGAS,

who in 1878 provided £4,000 to found an Engineering Scholarship, and in 1884 gave £6,000 for the endowment of a Chair of Chemistry.



THE LATE REV. WILLIAM ROBY FLETCHER, M.A.,

whose name will always be gratefully associated with the early days of the University. He was a member of the council from 1878 to 1890, and Vice-Chancellor from 1883 to 1886. He died in 1894.



LATE MR. PETER WAITE,

who in 1914 and 1915 made a gift to the University of Urrbrae Estate, Glen Osmond, comprising 134 acres and Mansion House, as well as the estate of Claremont and part of Netherby, comprising 165 acres, adjoining Urrbrae, "to advance the cause of education and more especially to promote the teaching and study of agriculture, forestry, and allied subjects." In 1918 he transferred to the University 5,880 shares in Elder Smith, & Co., Limited, "to provide funds to enable the University to utilize the land for the purposes intended."
