I wish to visit America from June to August, 1952, at the invitation of the University of North Carolina, to act as consultant at their Summer Conference on Statistics which is being held at Blue Ridge Assembly, from June 16th to July 25th. I have also been invited to deliver a lecture and receive an Honorary Degree at Chicago, to attend a Biostatistics Conference at Iowa State College, Ames and a Summer Seminar in Statistics at Storrs, the latter from August 4th to August 15th.

I wish to sail on the Queen Mary on June 5th, (Cabin A.150, Berth 1 has been reserved) and I shall return to England on August 16th by air (the reservation for this is now being made).
