My dear Balmukand:

I have your letter of 5 May 1932, with the paper on the Climatic Survey of the Punjab. I heartily hope you will be able to go ahead and make out a similar survey for the whole Province. It seems to provide a summary of the kind which is especially needed, at a time when crop data is qualitative and provisional.

You do not tell me whether you have ^{formed} ~~found~~ as yet any conclusions as to the reasons for the considerable and locally consistent differences in the percentage of landowners dying without sons. I suppose this data is from the land settlement department.
