We have just heard a disconcerting rumour to the effect that the Journal of Genetics may have to be discontinued. As we consider that this would be a very grave loss to genetics, we have been considering the possibility that the Genetical Society might do something in the matter. The subscription at present is quite nominal; and by raising it to a sum comparable with that of other scientific societies, it might be possible for the publication of the Journal to be continued. We think that a number of members of the Society would favour this suggestion; and would ourselves wish to bring it before the Society, if in your opinion we could thereby save the journal.
