Thanks for your note. I should like to know more about the S-alleles in your diploid potatoes. How many did you actually find and how much material did the survey cover? In fact I believe that we could learn more about the S-allele than Lewis has been able to elucidate by measuring the possibility that a stock containing initially only three or four alleles is found later to contain more.
