I will have to make some enquiries in regard to what information is available in connection with mast years, particularly in the far north. A great deal of the area in which lemmings occur has a very small amount of tree growth and the rate of growth of what trees there are is so slow that I imagine their seed production is very small in magnitude and would have little relationship to the lemming population. I will write you later after I have made some enquiries.
