My dear von Verschuer,

I forget whether I sent you the first of these two Letters to Nature, but I should like you to have them both in any case, and in case you are interested, also two Letters of last year in the British Medical Journal and a popular lecture I gave in the United States on the problem as it seemed to me then.

I am not sure what further data are likely to come on this subject. Some time ago Friberg wrote to me from Lund that he was doing a twin research there, and I believe Luca Cavalli-Sforza is getting some data in the Parma region. Probably, also, there will be some studies of the same kind in the United States.

I have been hoping to interest a group in Belgium centred on Dr Leopold Martin, whom perhaps you know as Secretary of the Belgian Region of the Biometric Society, to see whether the genotypic differences first recognizable in your own data can be associated with any of the known blood groups or combinations of them.
