Extract from the Rules made by the Lord Chamberlain.

(1) The name of the actual and responsible Manager of the Theatre must be printed on every play bill. (3) Where there is a fireproof screen to the proscenium opening it must be lowered at least once during every performance to ensure its being in proper working order. (4) All gangways, passages and staircases must be kept free from chairs or any other obstructions, whether permanent or temporary.

## WHY NOT THE TOTAL ABOLITION OF THE ENTERTAINMENT

The Chancellor of the Exchequer would not lose because those entertainments which showed a profit would still be subject to Tax under Income Tax, and entertainments which made a loss would pay no Tax, but would be employing labour.
